

Angelina College Standing Committees

Admissions Committee

Membership: The committee will consist of full-time faculty. Ideally each division, as well as one developmental program, will be represented.

Description: The committee will evaluate and make recommendations concerning admission policy. The committee will also review student petitions for admission or readmission.

Beautification and Safety Committee

Membership: The committee will consist of full-time faculty and staff.

Description: The standing committee will make recommendations for existing and new beautification projects for the campus. The committee will make recommendations for improved campus safety and security.

Committee on Instructional Technology

Membership: The committee will consist of faculty members, preferably one from each division, and administrative staff, including one member from MIS.

Description: This ad hoc committee will recommend policies and will advise regarding the acquisition, expansion, and use of technology and computers for administrative or instructional purposes.

Curriculum Committee

Membership: The committee shall be made up of at least one non-director full-time faculty member from each instructional division.

Description: The Curriculum Committee is an advisory committee whose primary responsibility is to ensure that the curriculum is consistent with the philosophy and purpose of the College. The committee has established procedures for review of proposed changes in the curriculum.

Honors and Awards Committee

Membership: The committee will consist of faculty members and administrative staff.

Description: The function of this standing committee is to recognize all especially deserving individuals in the college community and assist with special events.

Library and Instructional Media Committee

Membership: The committee will consist of a number of full-time instructors at least equal to the number of instructional divisions.

Description: The purpose of this standing committee is to determine policy in consultation with the Library Director on matters of general library-media center policy and to integrate library-media center operations with other academic activities of the College.

Scholarship Committee

Membership: The committee will consist of full-time faculty, with each division represented by one or more members.

Description: The committee will award academic scholarships to eligible students and formulate scholarship policies.

Student Activities and Athletics Committee

Membership: The committee will consist of full-time faculty and administrative staff as recommended by the Committee on Committees.

Description: The committee will review policies, goals, and objectives and make recommendations after receiving faculty input pertaining to the five areas of campus organizations and clubs, student conduct, intramural and intercollegiate athletics, performing arts, guest lecture, and entertainment, publications.

Wellness Committee

Membership: The committee will consist of full-time faculty and administrative staff as recommended by the Committee on Committees.

Description: The purpose of this standing committee is to review and make recommendations for the Employee Wellness Program.

Committee on Committees

Membership: The committee will consist of a number of full-time instructors at least equal to the number of standing committees.

Description: The standing committee will recommend appointments to the various committees and review the committees' functions and activities each year.

Faculty Forum (By election)

Membership: All members will be full-time tenured faculty. One member will be elected by each of the six instructional divisions. Elected members serve three year terms before rotating off. Two additional full-time faculty members will be selected by the general faculty.

Description: The Faculty Forum is a standing committee whose purpose is to facilitate communication between the faculty and the administration. The committee should present general faculty issues and viewpoints.

Quality Enhancement Plan (QEP) Committee (By appointment)

Membership: The steering committee members were **appointed** by the administration.

Description: The Quality Enhancement Plan Steering Committee will continue the development of the Plan. The committee will monitor the implementation and evaluation of the QEP campus wide.
