

General Information History and Philosophy

The Community Services Division is committed to the people of East Texas to offer continuing educational services accessible by persons of all ages. Programs offered include courses, seminars, workshops, institutes and teleconferences which provide lifelong learning opportunities. These programs allow persons to learn skills for new jobs, to add knowledge and skills needed in current jobs, to refresh and update job skills, to explore new fields, to have access to training required by law for their profession, to supplement current educational endeavors, and to enrich their lives with cultural and personal development training. To achieve these program goals, the Community Services Division publishes a schedule of classes for the fall, spring and summer. Input from persons in the community is encouraged at all times for determining offerings. If you have a suggestion, please communicate it to us. Many classes in our schedule are six weeks or less and classes begin and end at different times. This flexibility allows us to serve the needs of the community on short notice. A few courses test and grade skills for entry into new jobs, but most have no tests or grades and are simply based on attendance and participation. **Certificates of completion** are offered for all courses and a record of courses taken by all persons is maintained in our office. In addition to our courses, the Community Services Division reserves and prepares college facilities for use by outside persons, groups and organizations. If you have a need for facility use for meetings or presentations, please call us at 936-633-5400.

Payment Of Fees

The methods of payment for course fees are cash, personal or company checks, money order, DETCOG, WIA or TRC voucher, and VISA, MasterCard, Discover & American Express when paying in person. Students may register and pay by mail for any course listed using the clip-out coupon in the schedule. **Students must be registered 3 days prior to a class starting.** An organization paying for its employees to take classes may use the methods above or prearrange with the Business office for the college to invoice the organization for tuition and/or books. Please request a computer receipt for your registration.

Continuing Education Units (CEUs)

The Continuing Education Unit (CEU) is a nationally recognized method of recording participation in a continuing education program that does not carry credit toward a degree but does meet established criteria for increasing knowledge and competencies. One CEU is awarded for each 10 contact hours of participation in an organized non-credit continuing education program. Official transcripts are available upon request.

Financial Aid

The Community Services Division has a limited amount of financial aid assistance available under TPEG (Texas Public Educational Grant) to help students pay the costs of attending a career course scheduled. Any student needing financial assistance to enroll in a **career section** course should contact the Financial Aid Office at 936-633-5291. The student must complete a financial needs assessment form and show proof of income for the previous year, **(this includes all types of income for the whole household)** before a decision to offer assistance can be made. Financial assistance is **not** available for cultural, personal, children or driver safety courses. Financial assistance **does not** pay for books, supplies, or state testing fees. Some programs are approved for PELL and VA Benefits. Hazelwood may not be used for cultural or personal courses. Career courses are also eligible under WIA (Workforce Investment Act) for tuition assistance through the local Texas workforce Commission Office. Angelina College also has a JET GRANT which can be used to assist students with tuition in CERTIFIED MEDICAL LAB ASSISTANT & MEDICAL ASSISTING PROGRAMS. Please see the office of financial aid for application. Some financial aid is available to employees of small businesses in Angelina County who enroll in the college's small business course work. Contact the director of the Small Business Development Center at (936) 633-5400 for information.

Senior Citizen Tuition Policy

Persons aged 65 or older may enroll in any Community Services Cultural or Personal course listed in the class schedule for 50% of the course fee listed. This does not include driver safety, computer courses or any other course not listed in the Cultural or Personal sections of the schedule. Textbook or other course charges are not reduced or affected. Verification of age may be required. Senior class reference 3 letters, CUL, PER, etc.

Insufficient Check Penalties

Students are warned not to write insufficient checks or place stop payment on checks written for tuition or books.

The college business office will assess a \$25.00 per check charge in addition to the amount of tuition or book fees owed. The student will be denied the privilege of writing personal checks to the college for future payment of fees. Insufficient checks not paid promptly in the course of regular college collection efforts will be turned over to the county district attorney for collection of all amounts, service charges, and penalty fees assessed. Students must clear all unpaid financial obligations before they are allowed to register and pay for subsequent courses.

Withdrawals and Refunds

Students wishing to withdraw from a course may do so by notifying the Community Services office at 936-633-5206. **Any student seeking a refund must notify the Community Service office by telephone, in person, or in writing.** Should the college cancel a class, every effort is made to contact all the students enrolled. Students who wish to transfer to another Continuing Education class may do so at this time or receive 100% refund. Refunds are sent to the student by mail from the college business office. Refunds may take up to 30 days to receive. Students seeking refunds on textbooks must contact the college bookstore. Refunds are processed under the guidelines in the following table.

STUDENT SUPPORT SERVICES FOR CONTINUING EDUCATION:

In addition to financial aid services described in this schedule, the Community Services office offers the following for continuing education students:

- 1. COUNSELING** - The full time professional personnel of the Community Services office are here to help you choose appropriate courses and can answer questions you have about courses and certifications to work. Please contact the office at (936) 633-5206 or come by the office 8 AM - 5 PM Monday through Friday, to schedule an appointment or speak with the professional staff.
- 2. AFTER ENROLLMENT** - Please call before you drive to the first class to make sure your class has made and is starting on time, and is in the room where scheduled. For most classes, it takes at least 5 people to make a class. You may call (936) 633-5206 or check the interactive community services schedule on the college website at angelina.edu.
- 3. BOOKS** - Most Community Services classes have textbooks which are your responsibility to obtain in the college bookstore before the first class day. Bookstore personnel can help you make sure the correct book is chosen. Books can also be ordered on-line on the college website at angelina.edu and shipped to you for a shipping charge.
- 4. CAN'T ATTEND OR NEED TO DROP A CLASS** - Please contact your instructor if you have a reason you cannot attend class. The responsibility is yours for making up work missed. If you need to drop a class please contact the office at (936) 633-5206. Any refund will be given according to the published refund schedule in the class schedule. Students may also drop and add a class before classes begin.
- 5. PARKING** - At the time of enrollment please request a temporary parking permit from the Community Services office for the car you will drive on campus. There is no charge to the Community Services student for parking or the permit. The temporary permit will keep your car from being ticketed by campus security during the time you are in class.
- 6. MEALS** - There are snack and drink vending machines in most classroom buildings on campus. Community Services students may also, purchase meal tickets in the college business office for any of the 3 daily meals and may also go to the cafeteria and pay for an individual meal. Please remember eating and drinking are not allowed in most classrooms on campus.
- 7. EMERGENCIES** - In the event of a campus emergency which causes evacuation, please follow the evacuation plan posted in the building you are in. If you become ill and need medical attention while in class, please have your instructor contact the Community Services office to send medical personnel or ambulance.
- 8. UNLAWFUL ACTIVITY** - It is unlawful to bring drugs, firearms or weapons on campus, or to threaten or harass another person. If you are a victim or a witness to illegal activity taking place, please report the incident to the Community Services office or teaching center office who will call campus security or the police.
