

Diagnostic Medical Sonography Program Admission Point Value System

After all admission criteria have been satisfied, students will be top-ranked based on the GPA of the six prerequisites. The top 20 students will be interviewed. Eight to ten students will be selected according to a point value system as follows:

POSSIBLE POINTS

1. **GPA of six sonography program prerequisites:**

Points earned equals GPA multiplied by 5. Maximum 20

2. **Former Education (not required):**

Degree earned from a regionally accredited institution.

Master's Degree	Maximum 5
BSRS	Maximum 4
BS	Maximum 3
BA	Maximum 2
AAS	Maximum 1

3. **Former College/University Course Work:**

Completed with a grade of:

A = 3 points

B = 1 points

Medical Terminology Maximum 3

4. **Work Experience (not required):**

To receive credit must hold a 2 year credential in a health care field with a minimum of 1 year experience.

5 years	Maximum 5
3 years	Maximum 3
1 year	Maximum 1

A letter from your employer stating date of hire and your daily responsibilities or tasks is required.

5. **Anatomy & Physiology grade:** Maximum 7
A = 7 points
B = 3 points
6. **Interview:** Maximum 60
Candidates will be interviewed on an individual basis
by an interview committee.
