Diagnostic Medical Sonography Program Admission Point Value System

After all admission criteria have been satisfied, students will be top-ranked based on the GPA of the six prerequisites. The top 20 students will be interviewed. Eight to ten students will be selected according to a point value system as follows:

1. GPA of six sonography program prerequisites:

Points earned equals GPA multiplied by 5.
