

Diagnostic Medical Sonography Program Admission Point Value System

After all admission criteria have been satisfied, students will be top-ranked based on the GPA of the six prerequisites. The top 20 students will be interviewed. Ten students will be selected according to a point value system as follows:

	POSSIBLE POINTS
1. GPA of six sonography program prerequisites: Points earned equals GPA multiplied by 10.	Maximum 40
2. Former College/University Course Work: Completed with a grade of: A = 3 points B = 1 points Medical Terminology	Maximum 3
3. Anatomy & Physiology grade: A = 7 points B = 3 points	Maximum 7
4. Sonography Lab Hours 6 hours of volunteer/observation in the Sonography scanning lab (<6 hrs. completion = 0 points) Email cdavis@angelina.edu to schedule.	Maximum 10
5. Interview: Candidates will be interviewed on an individual basis by an interview committee.	Maximum 40

Must hold a 2-year credential in a health care field with a minimum of 1-year experience; a letter from your employer stating date of hire is required.
