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Transfer Opportunities

Transfer possibilities include nearby four-year universities with College of Education Bachelor's Degrees leading to teacher certification, such as Stephen F. Austin State University in Nacogdoches, TX, and Sam Houston State University in Huntsville, TX.

Career Opportunities and Salaries

This degree is designed to prepare students to pursue a Bachelor's degree in a teaching field. Openings for certified teachers (who have a Bachelor's degree and have passed a licensure exam) in Texas are available at public and private elementary, intermediate, middle, and high schools throughout the state. The minimum salary for a certified teacher with no experience at a Texas public school is \$28,080. Mid-career teachers make a minimum of \$42,310.
