Career Opportunities

With the completion of the CDA, a graduate is eligible to work in a daycare with a Headstart program. With either second level-one certificate, a graduate could expect to gain employment as a master teacher, site supervisor, special needs teacher, Head Start Teacher or Administrator, Pregnancy care worker, and more. With the completion of the AAS, a graduate could expect to find employment as the director of a childcare facility.

Advanced Degree and Certificate Opportunities

This pathway contains three certificates and one associate degree. Students are not required to do this sequence, this is only a recommended sequence for those wanting all four credentials. Students completing the AAS in Child and Family Development may transfer these credits into the Stephen F. Austin State University Bachelor in Human Development and Family Studies. Transfer students should speak with an AC success coach and an advisor at SFA prior to program completion.
