Licensed nurses can work in a variety of care environments including hospitals, doctors' offices, long-term-care facilities, schools, and more.

### Advanced Degree and Certificate Opportunities

Students complete the first year of the associate degree track plus vocational summer courses in preparation for vocational nurse licensure by examination. After completing the vocational nursing option, students may exit or continue through the second year of the curriculum and complete the associate degree nursing track. Through an agreement with TAMU, students can transition into a bachelor of nursing program after completing the AAS program at Angelina College.
