REGISTERING FOR THE TSIA2 EXAM

Instructions

1. Head over to this link <https://www.angelina.edu/tsia-assessment/>.
2. Scroll down to Step 1 and click "Sign up here."
3. Complete the TSI Pre-Assessment.
4. Head back to <https://www.angelina.edu/tsia-assessment/>.
5. Scroll down to Step 2 and click "Reservation Form for TSIA2."
6. Unless you would like to complete the exam in person, you should choose the remote option for the exam and pick a time that works best for you and reserve it. Be sure to choose to have your results sent to Angelina College.
7. Call the business office to pay for your TSI Exam. This must be done over the phone, the phone number for the business office is +1(936)633-5318.
8. Complete the TSI Exam at your scheduled time.

APPLYING FOR YOUR DORM

Instructions

1. Log into your MyAC Portal <https://myac.angelina.edu/ics>.
2. Click the "Student Services" tab at the top of the page.
3. Click the "Residence Life" link in the grey box on the left side of the page.
4. Scroll down to the "Housing- Forms" section of the page and select "2023-2024 Housing Application"
5. Complete the application and submit it. The application will require an American phone number. Use the number (936)671-7311 for now. When you are here and you move in you will sign a new form and you can add an international phone number.
6. Call the business office at +1(936)633-5318 to pay your dorm deposit OR pay your dorm deposit in person when you move in.

Instructions

1. Log into your MyAC Portal <https://myac.angelina.edu/ics>.
2. Select the "Students" tab at the top of the page.
3. Click the link that says "New Student Orientation" on the left side of the page in the grey box.

5. Read through each page of the orientation presentation and click "next" each time you are ready to move on.
