## Apply Texas Process

- Create an account.  
*Select **Get Started** and then **Create Account**.  
Create login credentials and select **Save**.*

 **Remember to record your login info!**

- Create your profile.
  - Select **Sign Up** and then **Start/Edit Profile**.
  - Complete each section, and move forward to the next section using the arrows at the bottom of the screen.
  - When you complete the last section, select **Done**.

*Note: Use capitalization properly.*

- Start your application.
  - Select **Start/Edit Applications** and then **Start an Application**.
  - Select a school, application type, semester, and major.
  - When you've finished each section, select **Done**.
- Submit your application.
  - Select **Submit** to submit your application.
  - Once submitted, the application will be transmitted to the school.
- Do a happy dance!
  - You're one step closer to college life.
- Receive your acceptance package.
  - Congratulations! Accepted students will receive an email and a letter in the mail.

# FAFSA Process

- Visit **studentaid.gov**.
- Create an account.
  - Select **Create Account** and follow the prompts to enter your personal information.
  - Fill out the requested information, then **Confirm** and **Verify** that all of your information is correct.

## Remember to record your login info!

- Gather your documents:
  - Social Security Card or Alien Registration Card
  - Driver's License
  - Federal Income Tax return for student and parents, W2's, and any other record of money earned for the specified year
- Start your application.
  - Select **Apply Now** then **Start Here** on the next page.
  - Follow the prompts to log in using your FSA ID and password.
- Enter your full name and date of birth as shown on your Social Security Card.
- Select the college you plan to attend.
  - Angelina College school code: 006661
- Follow the directions to determine dependency status.
- Provide parent demographics.
  - An email invite will be sent to parents to complete.
- Enter requested financial information.
- Sign and submit.
- Pat yourself on the back!
  - Your hard work could mean a big payoff – free college!
- Follow up.
  - Watch for an email requesting further documentation and/or information. You will receive an email confirming that your application has been processed.

# Veteran Educational Benefits

Discover exciting educational benefits tailored for veterans at Angelina College. We're here to support you on your academic journey, offering resources and opportunities to help you thrive. Join us in building a successful future together!

## Chapter 30

The MGIB provides a monthly stipend to veterans and service members to help pay tuition, fees, housing, etc.

## Chapter 31

The Veteran Readiness and Employment program offers opportunities for employment, education, job training, vocational counseling, and rehabilitation to eligible veterans and servicemembers.

## Chapter 33

Chapter 33 Post 9/11 covers tuition and fees for eligible veterans and servicemembers and provides a monthly housing allowance.

## Chapter 35

The Survivors and Dependents Educational Assistance (DEA) Program offers educational opportunities to eligible dependents of totally disabled veterans and veterans who died while on active duty or as a result of a service-related condition.

## Chapter 1606

The MGIB-SR provides educational opportunities for eligible members of the reserve components of each military branch, the Army National Guard and the Air National Guard.

## Chapter 1607

The Reserve Educational Assistance Program (REAP) provides up to 36 months of education benefits to members of the Selected Reserves, Individual Ready Reserve (IRR), and National Guard, who are called or ordered to active service in response to a war or national emergency, as declared by the President or Congress.

## Texas Hazlewood Act

The Texas Hazlewood Act provides eligible veterans, spouses, and children with 150 hours of tuition and fee exemptions at state-supported colleges and universities.

## VA Process

- Apply to AC.
  - Submit an application at **angelina.edu** and complete all admissions requirements.
- Complete the FAFSA (optional).
  - Visit **studentaid.gov** to apply for Federal Student Aid and determine your financial aid eligibility.
  - All students who plan to enter an associate degree program are encouraged to complete the FAFSA.

- Contact the VA Coordinator in AC Veterans Affairs.
  - Call (936) 633-5356 to speak with the VA Coordinator, who will advise you on the process and requirements for receiving veterans educational benefits at AC.
- Apply for VA Education Benefits.
  - Chapters 30, 31, 33, 35, 1606 and 1607: Apply online at **va.gov/education/how-to-apply**.
  - Texas Hazlewood Act: Apply online at **tvc.texas.gov/education/hazlewood**. Follow instructions under "How to Apply."
- Get advised and register for classes.
  - Contact the Office Academic Success at **oas@angelina.edu** to schedule an appointment with your Success Coach.
- Complete an Enrollment Certification Request Form.
  - Students must submit their classes for certification each semester in order to be awarded VA benefits.
  - Visit **angelina.edu/veterans** to access the form.
  - Enter the requested information and submit for review.
  - Only classes in your degree plan will be certified.

# Required Documents Checklist

Once you've received your acceptance to Angelina College, check your email for a list of required documents, including Bacterial Meningitis Immunization records, high school transcripts, and TSIA2 scores or exemptions. Submit these to Roadrunner Central, Student Center 1st floor, or email [documents@angelina.edu](mailto:documents@angelina.edu). *Please note: Official transcripts may not be sent through email.*

## Submit your transcripts.

- Submit your official high school transcript (with graduation date) and/or other college/university transcripts.
- Official Transcripts should be sent directly from the Institution by mail or through a secure electronic service
- Unofficial transcripts may be accepted if you are registering before you graduate.

## Turn in vaccination records.

- All students under the age of 22 taking classes must submit bacterial meningitis vaccination records.
- Your immunization must be within 5 years and at least 10 days from the first day of class.

## Submit your test scores.

- Submit official TSIA2 scores (unless you are exempt).
- If you have not taken the TSI, please note that the AC Testing Center offers the TSI Placement Exam. Schedule an exam appointment at [angelina.edu/testing](http://angelina.edu/testing).
- This college placement assessment includes three sections: Math, Reading, Writing. For more information about the TSIA2, go to [angelina.edu/tsia-assessment](http://angelina.edu/tsia-assessment).

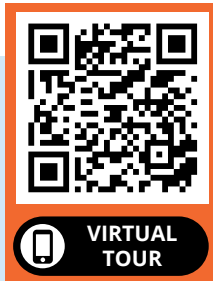
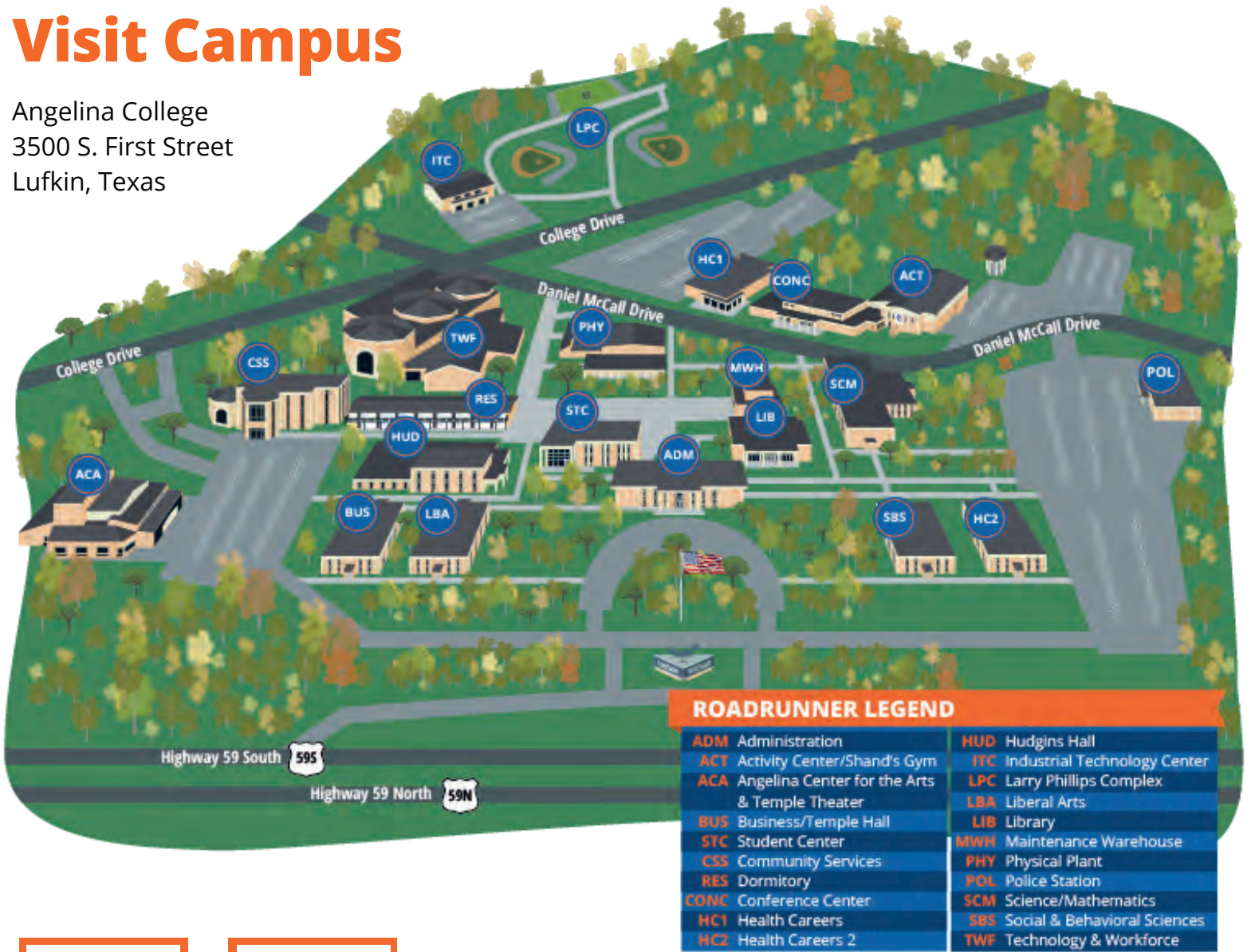
