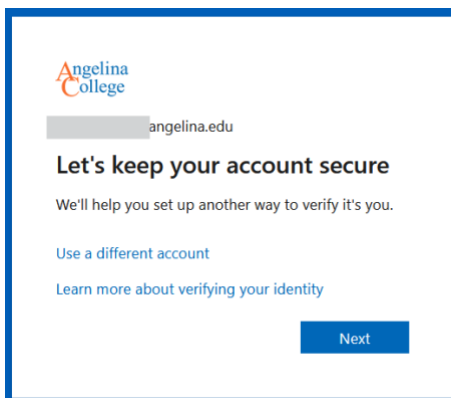


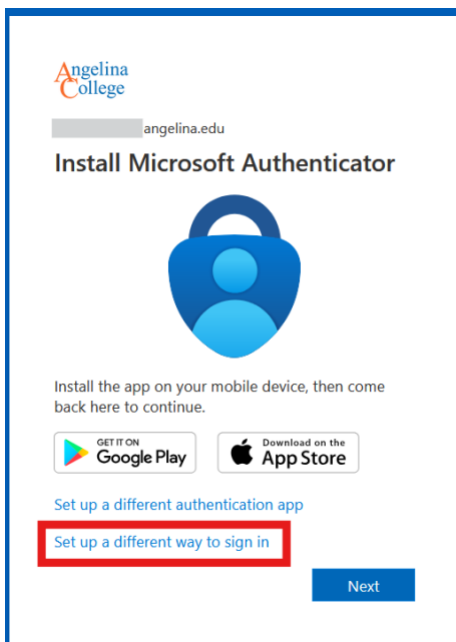
# Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) Initial Setup with Text Messages

Multifactor authentication (MFA), also known as two-factor authentication (2FA), is a feature which allows users to better protect their account by requiring additional steps when signing in. MFA increases security on your account by requiring you to first sign in using your username and password, then approve the sign in request using a second factor like your mobile phone.

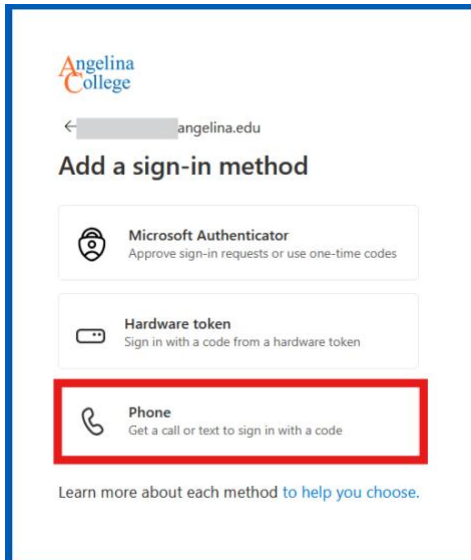
1. When logging in to AC Email or MyAC Portal, you will be prompted with the “Let’s you’re your account secure” screen. Select “Next”.



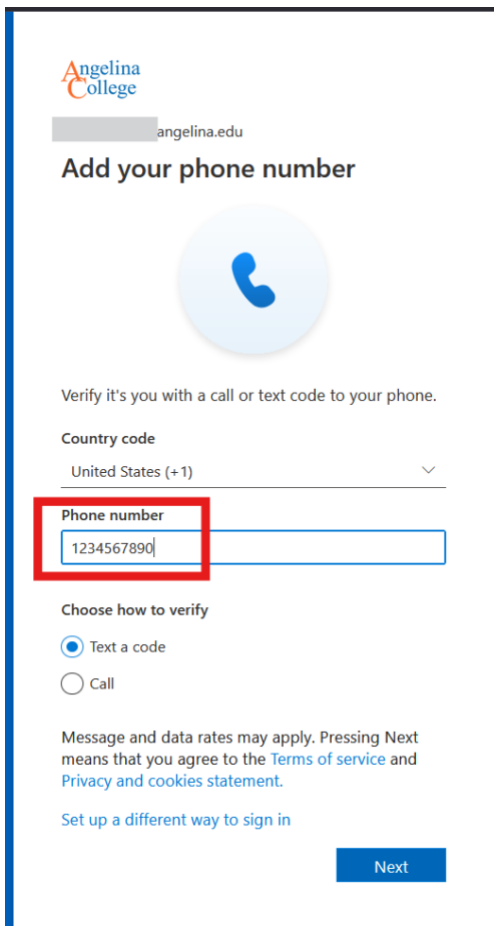
2. The next prompt will ask you to get the Microsoft Authenticator app. Do Not install the Authenticator app. Instead, select “Set up a different way to sign in”



- From the Add a sign-in menu, select "Phone"



- Enter your Phone Number in the "Phone number" field and click "Next"



5. You will receive a 6 digit code via text to your phone. Enter that code in the space provided and select "Next"
